Float Update was provided by Gina Duxbury (filling in for Curt Gore). The flyer has been completed and our position in the parade is #51. Those participating in the parade should wear western attire or FHCS shirts. The children participating in the parade will be handing out party blowers. The final meeting will be at the home of Curt Gore on the Monday before Thanksgiving to wrap everything up. Business cards were ordered to be distributed throughout the parade route.

The Harvest Dinner will run two seating times. The first seating will be for the younger children and their families beginning at 11:15 am and the second seating for the older children will begin at 11:45 am. Arrangements were made for the ordering and the pick-up of the turkeys from Safeway. Supplies for the dinner were discussed and arranged for. Larissa will set up on Monday for the book fair. An online feature will be open as well for post fair ordering. The online application will close out on Tuesday.

A storage unit has been secured for donated items for the garage sale. The unit is 10 x 10 in size and has a lock with code. A gate code is needed for entrance. Administration will communicate with school families when the unit is available. The event is scheduled for January 28th. The Middle School students will be providing food and beverages during the event.

The announcement of Babysitting Night was made by Karyn Miller. This is a fundraising event for the middle school. A flyer has been designed and will be distributed. The cost is \$25.00 per child and the service will be provided from 3:15 pm to 8:00 pm on Friday, December 2nd.

The Silent Auction/-Mid First Truck Update. To date, 50 items have been donated for the auction. The fundraising van has been secured. This is a great fundraiser for our school. Mid-First Bank will match our change donations up to \$1,000.00. These events are scheduled for February 29th.

The Kid's Raffle has a total of 9 baskets and the Glenbrook campus was provided their free raffle tickets today, November 16th. Volunteers were sought and found to sell tickets before and after school.

The Holiday Shopping extravaganza is set. Twenty-five vendors have been secured and the event is scheduled for Saturday, December 3rd beginning at 10:00 am. Ten percent of all sales come back to our school. Middle School students will be selling smencils and baked goods during the extravaganza.
